

Satin Luxe Foil Pumpkin

Halloween



Product Required:

8 x Anagram 35" White Satin Luxe Crescents 4183899

3 x Anagram Standard Mint Green Satin Luxe Stars 3991501

4 x Sempertex 260 Reflex Lime Green 3991501

Heat sealer or craft iron

Cable ties, or scraps of 260

Estimated Labour time: 20 minutes.

Construction Method:

- Stack the un-inflated crescents on top of each other, so that the points and balloon tails all line up perfectly, and the valve openings all face the same way.
- Pinch the points together tightly on one end of the crescents, and cable tie (or tie with 260 scraps) together as tight as possible about 2cm in from the tips.

Check the video on the Amscan Decorator Hub to ensure this is done securely.

- Repeat step 2 on the other end of the crescents.
- 4. Tie an uninflated 260 around and between the tips of the crescent furthest away from the balloon tails.
- 5. Inflate the crescents with air, one at a time, until they are all firm, but not over-inflated.
- 6. Tape up the tails.
- Create 3 x "leaves" from the standard satin luxe stars by folding in half, and heat sealing down the centre line. Remember to avoid the valve, and to leave a space for the air to pass into each half of the balloons. More detail can be found in a video specifically showing this technique on the Amscan Decorator Hub.
- Attach all the leaves together at the necks with a cable tie or 260 scrap.
- Make 3 "curly" balloons from 3 x 260 reflex Lime green, tie together, and add to the foil leaves.
- Attach the leaves and Curlies to the top of the pumpkin using the uninflated 260 attached in step 4.

These pumpkins can be created in a range of colours and sizes, and being constructed of air-filled foil, will last a very long time.
