## **Product Required:**

1 x Cheers Rose Anagram Junior Shape (4048401)

6 x 5" Sempertex Metallic Rose Gold Balloons (20009123)

6 x 5" Sempertex Satin White Balloons (20002011)

4 x 5" Sempertex Satin Pink Balloons (20002012)

3 x Faux Roses, Dusty Pink

Rose Gold Satin Ribbon

Metallic Silver Curling Ribbon (991001)

1.5m of 8mm Microbore Copper Tubing

Balloon Bond and Stretchy Balloon Tape

Estimated Labour time: 15 minutes

## **Construction Method:**

- 1. Roll the copper tube into a loose spiral and pull up on the centre to form the support as shown in the picture.
- 2. Create a 4-balloon cluster of 2 x rose gold, 1 x white and 1 x pink 5" balloons inflated to 3.5"
- 3. Create a 4-balloon cluster of 1 x white, 2 x pink and 1 x rose gold 5" balloons inflated to 2.5". Wrap this cluster into the cluster created in step 2 to form a collar and wrap tightly to the top of the copper spiral.
- 4. Create a 4-balloon cluster of 1 x pink, 2 x rose gold and 1 x white 5" balloons inflated to 2". Wrap this around the copper spiral, halfway up.
- 5. Create a 4-balloon cluster of 2 x pink, 1 x rose gold and 1 x white 5" balloons and wrap around the copper spiral, close to the bottom.
- 6. Cut the stems of the roses to about ½" long and cover the cut ends with a small piece of stretchy balloon tape to protect the balloons.
- 7. Attach one rose to each latex cluster with a little balloon bond.
- 8. Make 3 x bows with the stain ribbon, and tie around with silver curling ribbon. Tie one bow into each latex cluster.
